 2. All events funded by BCireland should be submitted to BCireland to be included in the newsletter, Facebook, Twitter and website.
 3. All events funded by BCireland **can only be hosted by BCireland members** for insurance purposes.
 4. A brief report must be submitted to BCireland no later than 1st November 2016 in order to receive funding.
 5. Receipts relating to the funded project should be submitted along with the report in order to receive funding although, depending on project requirements and at the discretion of BCireland, some projects may receive partial pre-payment of no more than 50% of the total costs.
 6. BCireland logo is required to be used in the promotion of projects funded by this grant scheme and BCireland funding must be acknowledged in reports, publications or broadcasts that derive from grant funding.
 7. Additional conditions may apply depending on the project funded.
 8. Applicants are required to be a current member of Bat Conservation Ireland.
 9. No overhead or administration costs (e.g. university administration costs) will be covered by this grant, if awarded.
